**REGISTRATION INFORMATION**

When mixing classes at different levels, the higher fee amount prevails.

There is a non-refundable Youth Ballet Membership Fee (\$15/student, \$20/family) and registration fee (\$15 /student).

Registration is on a first come, first served basis; payment of registration fee reserves a spot in the class.

Fees may be paid by pre-authorized monthly direct withdrawal, cash, cheque or credit card. Pre-authorized payment is preferred.

5% Discount for paying fees in full for the year. This discount does not apply to supplementary fees or fundraising.

Family discounts available.

One month’s written notice is required for With-drawl from classes; a \$20 admin fee will be charged for refunds of supplementary fees. No costume refund will be available after January 1<sup>st</sup>.

Discounted fees for Post- Secondary students participating in Post- Secondary Classes.

All classes must meet minimum enrollment or the class may be cancelled or combined with another class. This will be at the discretion of Youth Ballet.

## FUNDRAISING

(Excludes families in RAD, Adult non performing, Adapted and Explore Dance)

Each family at the Youth Ballet is assigned a fundraising commitment, except for the students mentioned above. These funds are used to sustain the school's operations and for costs associated with the Spring School Recital. No money from these commitments is used towards the Company or the Royal Academy of Dance program.

Your family's fundraising commitment is based on the number of classes taken per week by all members of your family who are students of Youth Ballet

1 Class per week \$60 per family per year  
2 Classes per week \$120 per family per year  
3 Classes per week \$180 per family per year  
4 Classes per week \$240 per family per year  
5 Classes per week \$300 per family per year (\$300 Maximum)

### Fundraising Options:

Funds may be raised by working bingos (\$60 value per bingo), selling cases of chocolates, (\$30 value per case sold), selling gift wrap or payout either in a lump sum or divided evenly with monthly fees. You may also do various other things, if needed, such as sewing costumes, building props, etc. for credit on your account. Once your commitment is met, you will not have to do any other fundraising for the year. Please indicate your choice of fundraising method on your registration form.

## Notes on Bingos

Bingos are held at the Regina Bingo Palace, 190 Broad Street N., every 4<sup>th</sup> Wednesday evening of the month, from 5:15 until 12:15 am. Parking is free and the hall is smoke-free. You may bring your own supper or purchase it at the Bingo Palace canteen.

Once you have worked off your fundraising requirement, you may work additional bingos, which will be credited to your child's account. If you wish to take advantage of this, please wait until 3½ weeks prior to Bingo Wednesday before signing up in any available slots. (This is to allow those who need to meet their fundraising needs the opportunity to sign up first.)

Sign-up sheets are posted in the outer office. Please sign-up in person or by calling Youth Ballet office at 352-9908. Sign-up sheets will remain available until the Friday 1 ½ weeks prior to the Wednesday Bingo. Additions and/or deletions after that time may be made by calling Sophia Caporicci at 306-541-0480. Questions pertaining to credits and/or accounts should be directed to the Youth Ballet office.

Any person who signs up to work a Bingo but cancels 1 ½ weeks prior to the Bingo date without providing a replacement worker will be charged \$90.00.

The Bingo Hall occasionally offers Youth Ballet to work at additional Bingos. When this occurs, it is usually on short notice and on weekends or nights other than Wednesday. If you wish to be given the opportunity to work at these, please advise Sophia Caporicci at the above number.
